**Divine Mercy Sunday** In 2000, Pope John Paul declared a Polish nun, Faustina Kowalska, to be a saint. She was mystic, having visions of Jesus telling her to promote attendance at Mass and Confession to receive mercy. She died in 1938 at the age of 33. She also instructed people to pray before an image of the risen Jesus characterised by his pierced hand near his heart from which flow red and blue rays, often with the words, 'Jesus I trust in you'. Divine Mercy is always the 2nd Sunday of Eastertide - today.
