Maundy Thursday: Sung Mass etc at 7.30pm

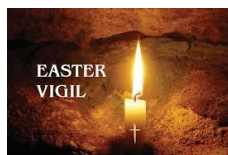
Good Friday: 10.00am Solemn Liturgy (Hot X buns after)
